Zero Tolerance Policy – Winter 2025/2026

We are excited to welcome you to the 2025/2026 Indoor Winter Youth Soccer League. This year's league includes both new and returning teams at all age groups. For those joining us for the first time, welcome to Union Point Sports—and to our returning teams, welcome back!

To ensure a safe, positive, and enjoyable environment for all players, coaches, officials, and families, the Union Point Sports Youth Soccer League will enforce the following **Zero Tolerance Policy** throughout the season. Please review these rules carefully and share them with all coaching staff, players, and parents.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

The Union Point Sports Youth Soccer League maintains a strict zero-tolerance policy regarding the behavior of managers, coaches, players, spectators, and all attendees.

Our goal is to create an atmosphere where:

- Players and families feel safe
- Coaches and officials can perform their duties without harassment
- Games are conducted in a positive, sportsmanlike environment

These rules are **not** intended to limit positive cheering or appropriate coaching instruction. They are designed to prevent negative, disruptive, and abusive behavior of any kind.

LEAGUE RULES

1. Negative Behavior Toward Others



Any negative comments or disrespectful conduct directed toward managers, coaches, players, referees, or Union Point Sports staff will result in **immediate removal** of the offender from the facility.

- If a spectator is involved, they will be required to leave the dome immediately.
 - If the individual refuses to leave, **the game will stop** until they comply.
 - Refusal to leave will also result in suspension from future games.
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2. Ejections & Suspensions

For team personnel (managers, coaches, and players):

- **First Ejection:** Automatic minimum **one (1) game suspension**
 - **Second Ejection in the Same Season:** Indefinite suspension pending a review by Union Point Sports staff.
 - If reinstated and a third ejection occurs: Immediate removal for the remainder of the season, with inability to participate in any remaining league games going forward.
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3. Physical Altercations

Any physical confrontation involving spectators, managers, coaches, players, referees, or staff will result in immediate removal from the dome.

No exceptions. Further disciplinary action will apply.

4. Parent Interference

Parents and spectators must not excessively communicate with players during gameplay.

- If such behavior disrupts the coaching staff's ability to manage the team, the individual may be asked to leave the dome.
 - Continued interference may result in removal and/or suspension.
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5. Profanity & Verbal Abuse

Any manager, coach, or player who uses profanity directed toward a referee or Union Point Sports staff member will be immediately ejected. Verbal abuse of any kind will **not** be tolerated.
